### American Business Women's Association Bay Area Vision Chapter Standing Rules

1. The Chapter Standing Rules will be approved by the membership at the August monthly meeting. They will be distributed to the membership and to all new members.
2. The Executive Board may approve bills up to \$400.00 without the approval of the membership.
3. The Chapter will spend no more than \$50.00 on gifts for the outgoing President.
4. The Chapter will spend up to \$50.00 per member on gifts, cards, or plants for a recognition of the death or illness of a member's immediate family.
5. The Chapter will vote to send representatives to the Spring Conference and or Representatives and a delegate to the National Convention. The amount paid towards registration for the representatives/delegate will be voted on depending on the financial condition of the treasury.
6. The Chapter will at the discretion of the Board of Directors spend up to \$100.00 per event to advertise in local media for prospective members or to obtain publicity for the Chapter.
7. The Chapter meeting minutes and Treasurer's report will be printed in the Newsletter.
8. The Chapter will at the discretion of the Board of Directors allocate up to \$100.00 per event for educational speakers, events, or programs depending on the financial condition of the treasury.
9. The Chapter will contribute to the Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund each year. The amount will be determined each year by the Executive Board depending on the financial condition of the treasury.
10. Each new member will be given an orientation packet and name tag by the membership committee.
11. The Chapter will have the following committees not covered by the Chapter bylaws: Scrapbook Committee and Sunshine Committee and the position of Treasurer-elect.
