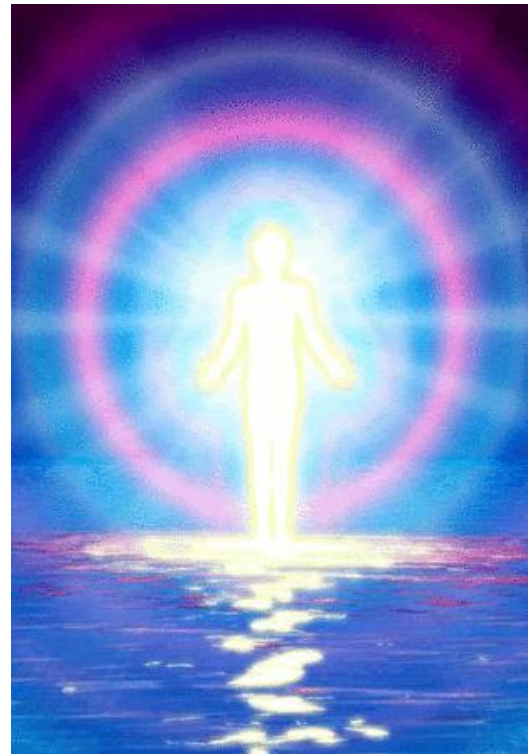
### Friday Evening
