Dan and Rachel bring new album “Damn Monsters!” on Spring European Tour

Musical and romantic duo Dan and Rachel, fresh from the studio with their new album, “Damn Monsters!” will be playing their second European Tour from April 12 through May 19.

An electro-folk duo from Brooklyn, NY, Dan and Rachel play loud dance music, soft folk songs, and everything in between. Since 2009 they have toured over 20 countries, playing internationally acclaimed venues including Webster Hall (NYC), El Lokal (ZURICH) and the Reeperbahn Festival (HAMBURG). While they have recorded together for five years, “Damn Monsters!”, is their first full album collaboration. Recorded in an old church in Brooklyn, “Damn Monsters” is a louder, synth-laden extension of their original antifolk art-rock music.

Dan and Rachel are also active participants in the Brooklyn D.I.Y music community, the organic food movement, and the New York Antifolk Scene. In 2007 they founded Brooklyn Tea Party, a non-political live/work space in Bushwick, ushering in the now bursting house-concert tradition in Brooklyn’s artist community.

In 2010 Dan and Rachel curated the first ever New Artists Program at the 30th Annual Old Songs Festival in Altamont, New York.

Rachel Devlin is also a yoga teacher. Dan Costello has released four solo albums and was a member of the pop group Creaky Boards.
