Question: Hey so i'm writing a song in E minor and want to change the key to G major halfway through but

cant get the transition right.

Answer: Hey, thanks for the email. When I try to change a song into a different key in the middle of the song, I try two different things. First, I play the song as it was written until I get to the key change. At the key change, I play an E minor chord, followed by an E major chord and then finally, I would play the G Chord this sets the song from Minor, to Major, to G Major. If you are playing a melody with the song, and want to include a melody with the change play a melody and end on a B or D. This sets the mood to change into a good compatible key for you to change to G Major. For your convenience, I have started a newsletter podcast with an example for these's methods to change keys.
