PASTOR EUGEN GROZA VISITS

Pastor Eugen Groza is the president and chairman of Missio Link International in Romania. He was persecuted for his belief in Jesus during communism in Romania and actively participated in the revolution and the fall of communism.

In the chaos of Romania's Revolution, Eugen helped to start one of Romania's first evangelical organizations which became one of the largest, most effective evangelical ministry in Eastern Europe.

Mli includes several ministries under its umbrella including the Deborah House which is a facility that sup-

ports abused and abandoned girls close to Timisoara.

Christ in freedom is sometimes more difficult than to be willing to die for Christ under persecution."

Now we are planning the first trip to The Deborah House in Romania out of First Baptist Church Woodstock from July 14th through the 23rd of 2012.

TANGIBLE MINISTRY NEEDS

There are a couple immediate and tangible ministry needs. With the upcoming mission trip, it has become necessary to purchase Quickbooks for Non-profits. This costs about \$400.

My laptop has been acting up for quite some time now. I took it in and the fix costs \$400 or about 2/3 of what

a new computer costs. With the advances since the laptop was originally purchased, the recommendation is to get a new laptop.

We are hoping to take a group of eight to Romania this summer at a cost of \$2,500 per person. We will have two in our family going to Romania to minister to

these hurting (and PRAISE GOD healing) young girls.
