MARWOOD

New York, well known for its rock exports, sends Marwood to Arlington this month for an Iota show with former On Tap music editor Mike Holden. Marwood's sound is pure guitar-driven rock, full of catchy melodies and hip rhythms that New York Newsday deemed "stunning alternative pop." A seasoned group of live performers, Marwood has performed countless shows over the past year, sharing the bill with artists including Antigone Rising, the Sam Roberts Band and Rooney, and performing to sold-out crowds at Planos and the Village Underground in the Big Apple. The band was recently distinguished out of 200 bands as a finalist in NYC's M.E.A.N.Y. festival-the winner of which is TBD at the end of December at a CBGB's gig. With radio airplay growing (including feature spins on Q104.3 in New York and on XM Satellite Radio) and the live dates stacking up, now is the time to catch Marwood live so you can say you saw them before they got big.
