- **Preschool Registration**

- \$50 due at registration (this is non-refundable).

- **Classes available**

- 2 years old by 9/1/11 – one day a week 9:00am – 11:15am
 - Tues \$45/month
 - Wed \$45/month
- 3 Years Old by 9/1/11 2 or 3 days a week 9:00am – 11:30am
 - Tues & Thurs \$75/month
 - Mon & Wed \$75/month
 - Mon – Wed – Friday \$95/month
- 4 years old by 9/1/11 3 or 4 days a week 9:00am – 11:30am
 - Mon – Wed – Fri \$95/month
 - Mon-Tues-Thurs-Fri \$115/month

Classes available may change or classes may be added.

- **Documents needed**

- Application – At time of Registration
- Pink Medical Emergency Form – During Parent Orientation
- Blue Parent Contract – During Parent Orientation
- White Parent Acknowledgement Form – During Parent Orientation
- White State Health form – Completed and signed by your doctor with all shots noted.
 - Needed within one week of starting school.
 - If your child attended last year we can use that form. However, if they have received more shots, we will need that information.



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• **Tuition**

- First and last month's tuition is due at the beginning of the year.
- Tuition due the first of each month late after the fifteenth with a \$10 late fee
- Please read the Tuition page of the Parent Handbook carefully. This will be available online or you may receive a paper copy if needed.

• **Parent Orientation:**

- Will be held the week before school starts. You will receive a letter to inform you of the time.
- This is a mandatory meeting – if you must miss – please schedule another time to meet with the teachers, before school starts.

• **Miscellaneous**

- Snack Bucket – The Teachers and the students will take turns bringing the snack bucket. A list of snack ideas is attached to the bucket. These must be commercially prepared & packages unopened per the Board of Health.
- Throat Check – We will conduct a health check starting 8:55am – 9:05am – Please make sure you arrive during that time. If your child is ill, has had a fever, vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours do not bring them to school.
- Playing is children's work – please dress them in clothes that can get dirty. We paint, stamp, use markers, eat snack and play outside all of these things can cause children to get their cloths dirty.
- Please pack a change of clothes, diapers or pull-ups as needed – accidents do happen.
